- How would you describe the responsibilities of the position?
- What type of background do you feel would be best suited for success in this position?
- How would you describe a typical day and week in this position?
- Is this a new position? If not, what did the previous employee go on to do?
- Who does this position report to? What is their management style?
- How many people work in this office/department?
- How much travel is expected?
- What is the typical work week schedule? Is overtime expected?
- What are the prospects for growth and advancement?
- How does one advance in the company?
- Are there any examples of a career path beginning with this position?
- Do you have a policy for helping new members of the team get on board?
- What are the biggest challenges of this job?
- What should I prioritize in the first 90 days?
- How would you describe this company's values?
- What are the company's plans for growth and development?
- What are the largest rewards of the job and working for this company?
- What is the best part of working for this company?
- What's your least favorite part of working here?
- Would you like a list of references?
- If I am extended a job offer, how soon would you like me to start?
- What can I clarify for you about my qualifications?
- When can I expect to hear from you?
- Are there any other questions I can answer for you?
- Do you have any reservations about my qualifications?

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
